**4. For Possible Action: Discussion and proposed adoption of changes to MSM Chapter 400 – Mental Health and Alcohol/Substance Abuse Services**

**Revisions to MSM Chapter 400 are being proposed to strengthen policy throughout the chapter, to ensure System of Care philosophy. Proposed revisions include adding verbiage to direct providers to appropriate chapter for Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services and;**

**Additional proposed revisions include further clarification language to promote the importance of the System of Care core philosophy and approach of family driven, community based and culturally and linguistically competent services, ensuring that recipients will receive individualized comprehensive health services that promote collaboration between providers, utilize evidence-based practices, and continue to be family driven community-based services.**

**Clarification that Rehabilitative Mental Health (RMH) services cannot be billed the same day as Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services and direct providers to the appropriate MSM Chapter.**

**5. For Possible Action: Discussion and proposed adoption of changes to MSM Chapter 3600 – Managed Care Organization**

Revisions to MSM Chapter 3600 are being proposed to incorporate the recent Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approval that Managed Care Organizations (MCO) could provide services within an alternative inpatient setting, when the facility is licensed by the State of Nevada, and services within the facility are provided at a lower cost than that of services provided within a traditional inpatient hospital setting.

These changes are retroactively applied to align with revised covered services outlined within the managed care contract amendment number five.
