Revisions to NMO-6160 are being proposed to clarify language in the form. The content remains the same, but the order of items has been changed for better flow and repeated content was deleted. Certain sentences were changed to make them more understandable (e.g. “Medicaid recipients aged 55 or older and/or permanently institutionalized are affected by this program and may be required to pay Medicaid benefits paid on their behalf after their death” changed to “Medicaid recipients aged 55 and older and/or permanently institutionalized are affected by this program and, after their death, may have Medicaid benefits they received be subject to recovery...” or to provide better wording (e.g. mentally retarded changed to individuals with intellectual disabilities). This form is given to all Medicaid applicants by the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services at the time of initial application to explain the Medicaid Estate Recovery program, which goes into effect upon the death of a recipient.

DHCFP proposes revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 1200, Appendix A, based on recommendations approved at the April 27, 2017 Drug Use Review (DUR) Board meeting. The DUR board recommended the removal of prior authorization criteria for Symlin® (Pramlintide Injection).

Providers who prescribe, dispense or administer this drug may be affected by this change, including but not limited to the following Provider Types (PTs): Outpatient Surgery (PT 10); Hospital, Inpatient (PT 11); Hospital, Outpatient (PT 12); Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities, Public (PT 16); Special Clinics (PT 17); Nursing Facility (PT 19); Physician/Osteopath (PT 20); Podiatrist (PT21); Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (PT 24); Pharmacy (PT 28); Home Health Agency (PT 29); Ambulatory Surgical Centers, Freestanding (PT 46); Indian Health Programs and Tribal Clinics (PT 47); Indian Health Service Hospital, Inpatient (Tribal) (PT 51), Indian Health Service Hospital, Outpatient (Tribal) (PT52); Transitional Rehabilitative Center, Outpatient (PT 55); Inpatient Rehabilitation and Long Term Acute Care (LTAC) Specialty Hospitals (PT 56); Hospice (PT 64); Hospice, Long Term Care (PT 65); Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities, Private (PT68); Nurse Anesthetist (PT 72); Critical Access Hospital (CAH), Inpatient (PT 75); Audiologist (PT 76); Physician’s Assistant (PT 77); Indian Health Service Hospital, Inpatient (Non-Tribal) (PT 78); Indian Health Service Hospital, Outpatient (Non-Tribal) (PT 79).
