Revisions to MSM Chapter 1100 are being proposed to add new language clarifying ocular prosthetic services. This incorporates the MSM current requirements for ocular prosthetics.

5. For Possible Action: Discussion and proposed adoption of changes to MSM Chapter 1200 – Prescribed Drugs

Revisions to MSM Chapter 1200 are proposed to reflect approved actions by the Drug Use Review (DUR) Board at the October 26, 2016 and January 26, 2017 meetings.

On October 26, 2016, new prior authorization criteria was approved for Epclusa® (sofosbuvir/ velpatasvir).

On January 26, 2017, revised prior authorization criteria was approved for buprenorphine/ naloxone (Suboxone®/Subutex®), Orkambi® (lumacaftor/ivacaftor) and medications for recipients on hospice. Prior authorization criteria were removed for Incretin Mimetics. Criteria were revised for evaluating recipients for the Lock-in Program.
