Subject: Supplemental Payment for Inpatient Hospitals

Attachment 4.19-A, Page 32b: The DHCFP is proposing an amendment to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan that would allow the continuation of the supplemental payment program based on inpatient hospital utilization in order to preserve access to inpatient acute services through SFY 2019. This amendment will also increase the supplemental payments from \$87,233,867.32 in SFY 2018 to \$96,367,052.42 in SFY 2019.

The following Provider Type (PT) will potentially be affected by this change: Hospital, Inpatient (PT 11).

Estimated Change in Annual Aggregate expenditures: SFY 2019: An increase in supplemental payments of \$9,133,185.10.

The effective date of change is July 1, 2018.

3. Discussion of Proposed Amendments to the State Plan for Medicaid Services and Solicitation of Public Comments

Subject: Proposed adoption of new 2017 CHIP State Plan Section 6 – Mental Health Addiction and Equity Act (MHPAEA) provided by Centers for Medicaid and CHIP Services (CMCS)

The CMCS provided States with a new CHIP State Plan Template. The new Template incorporates guidance submitted to States through State Health Official (SHO) letters. Categories include; prenatal care, coverage of pregnant women, tribal consultation requirements, dental and supplemental dental benefits, premium assistance, Express Lane eligibility and lawfully residing requirements.

The following Provider Type (PT) will potentially be affected by this change: This proposed change will not affect Medicaid/CHIP-enrolled providers delivering MHPAEA services.

Estimated Change in Annual Aggregate expenditures: No change in annual aggregate expenditures is anticipated.

The effective date of change is October 2, 2017.
