The State Plan will be amended to update the agency rates and effective dates. This date requires amendment due to a reduction in the Basic Skills Training (H2014) rate. The State Plan currently reflects the date the fee schedule for this service was established. The new rate for Basic Skills Training will be changed on January 1, 2019, therefore, the effective date of this change must be reflected in the State Plan.

The following Provider Types (PTs) will potentially be affected by this change: This proposed change affects all Medicaid-enrolled providers delivering Basic Skills Training for Behavioral Health Services. Those provider types include Outpatient Behavioral Health (PT 14) and Rehabilitative Mental Health (PT 82). The Basic Skills Training rate is being reduced; however, no change to the rate methodology is occurring.

Estimated change in annual aggregate expenditures: An estimated decrease in annual aggregate expenditures for

SFY 2018:	\$(2,419,164)
SFY 2019:	\$(4,919,611)

The effective date of change is January 1, 2019.
