1. Discussion of proposed Amendments to the State Plan for Medicaid Services and solicitation of public comments

Subject: Correcting Attachment 4.19-B, Page 1c (d)

The purpose of the State Plan Amendment (SPA) is to correct the language in Attachment 4.19-B, Page 1c, Subparagraph (d).

This proposed change affects all Medicaid-enrolled providers delivering Physician, M.D., Osteopath type of services. Those PTs include, but are not limited to: Physician, M.D., Osteopath (PT20).

Estimated change in annual aggregate expenditures: No change in annual aggregate expenditures is anticipated.

The effective date of change is July 1, 2018.

2. Discussion of proposed Amendments to the State Plan for Medicaid Services and solicitation of public comments

Subject: State Plan Attachment 3.1A, Page 3a Continued and Page 3d

Revisions to State Plan, Attachment 3.1A Page 3a Continued and Page 3d are being proposed to ensure compliance with 42 CFR § 440.70 and 42 CFR § 440.80. The SPA removes language restricting the location of the provision of services to the recipient's place of residence and adds language that allows services to be provided in any setting where normal life activities occur.

This proposed change affects all Medicaid-enrolled providers delivering Home Health and Private Duty Nursing type of services. Those PTs include, but are not limited to: Home Health Agencies and Private Duty Nursing (PT 29).

Estimated change in annual aggregate expenditures: No change in annual aggregate expenditures is anticipated.

The effective date of change is July 1, 2018.

3. Discussion of proposed amendments to the State Plan for Medicaid Services and solicitation of public comments

Subject: Dental Rate Realignment

The DHCFP is proposing to revise the current payment methodology for PT 22 — Dental. The new methodology will utilize the 2016 relative value units to set rates for CDT codes.

The Nevada State Plan, Attachment 4.19 B, Page 2c, will need to be updated to reflect the proposed changes to the dental rate methodology.

The following provider types will be affected by this change: Dental (PT 22).

This change will result in an estimated decrease in annual aggregate expenditures of:
