The DHCFP proposes revisions to MSM Chapter 1200, Appendix A, to update the age in existing prior authorization criteria for Kalydeco® (ivacaftor) from "one year of age and older" to "six months of age and older" and Symdeko® (tezacaftor/ivacaftor) from "12 years of age and older" to "six years of age and older" based on updated Federal Drug Administration (FDA) approved indications.
