8. <u>Private duty nursing services</u>

Private duty nursing (PDN) services means nursing services provided by a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse under the direction of the recipient's physician. Services may be provided to children age 21 years or younger. PDN may not be provided to adults age 21 years or older and/or when the adult recipient has elected to receive hospice services. These services may be provided in the recipient's home and other settings where normal life activities occur. To qualify for these services, a recipient must require more individual and continuous care than is available from a visiting nurse or routinely provided by the nursing staff of the hospital or skilled nursing facility. These services are provided in accordance with 42 CFR 440.80 and other applicable state and federal law or regulation. These services are offered through a home health provider that is enrolled as a Medicare Certified Home Health Agency licensed and authorized by state and federal laws to provide health care services in the home.
