Purpose of the Workshop

3

- Discuss proposed changes to the Individualized Treatment Plan and Documentation requirements and solicit feedback from stakeholders and consumers.
- The current policy is outlined in Medicaid Services Manual (MSM), Chapter 400, Mental Health and Alcohol and Substance Abuse Services.

Purpose for Changes

4

- Changes to the treatment plan and documentation requirements were based on recommendations from stakeholders and consumers as well as those reviewing documentation external to the provider.
- The proposed changes will combined the current treatment plan and the rehabilitative plan in concert to offer a single, cohesive document referred to as the Individualized Treatment Plan.
- The Individualized Treatment Plan provides the recipient and the providers a process that promotes a personalized and comprehensive treatment that encourages patient-centered care.
- The Individualized Treatment Plan will require patient involvement (legal guardian where applicable) in the plan development and an understanding of prescribed services.

Purpose for Changes (cont.)

- The Individualized Treatment Plan requires coordination of care and services for the recipient.
- Changes to additional documentation requirements such as Progress Notes to ensure all appropriate information is captured.
- Progress notes should always relate back to the Goals and Objectives outlined in the Individualized Treatment Plan.
