- Sec. 10. 1. Except for health information concerning a patient who is prohibited by NRS 439.538 from opting out of electronic disclosure of individually identifiable health information, health information concerning a patient, including, without limitation, a child under 18 years of age who has received health care services without the consent of a parent or guardian, that is retrieved, disclosed or maintained using a health information exchange [is the property of] belongs to the patient. A patient may control access to such information by providing or refusing to provide informed written consent in the manner prescribed by this section.
- 2. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7, a person shall, before retrieving the health information of a patient that [is the property of] belongs to the patient pursuant to subsection 1 from a health information exchange:

Rationale: SB 48 outlines that we must establish who owns the patient's data. The property language is changed because we don't want to inadvertently subject a person to property laws.
