NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) will hold a public workshop to propose the adoption of All-Payer Claims Database (APCD) regulations Nevada Revised Statues (NRS) 439B.800 through 439B.875.

In support of existing law related to the quality, accessibility, and affordability of health care needs of the residents of this state, Senate Bill 40 was passed in the 81st (2021) Session of the Nevada Legislature and signed into law on June 7, 2021. The proposed APCD regulation NRS 439B.800 through 439B.875 will support this law. The purpose of the workshop is to

solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations:

The proposed regulations provide provisions for the following:

- 1. Details the creation, role, and functionality of the APCD Advisory Committee.
- 2. Provides information on the Advisory's Committee's composition, terms, and the compensation to each member. Members shall be appointed by the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).
- 3. Information on how the Advisory Committee Chair will be appointed and details of the terms each member will serve.
- 4. Details related to the Advisory Committee's duties and responsibilities for APCD data.
- 5. Requirements as it relates to the Department's Data Submission Guide.
- 6. Department's authority over the data files and the Data Submission Guide.
- 7. APCD historical data retention guidelines.
- 8. APCD data submitter requirements.
- 9. Defines penalties the Department may assess in accordance with the statute and outlines the data submitter's right to due process, which includes notice and the right to request a hearing.
- 10. Explains the waiver request process, reporting requirements, and deadlines of the waiver requests.

Members of the public may make oral comments at this meeting. Persons wishing to submit written testimony or documentary evidence may submit the material to APCD Core Team at APCD@STATE.NV.US or at the following address no later than August 30, 2023:
