# Nevada's HCBS Waiver for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities and Related Conditions

- First 1915 (c) waiver in Nevada – originated in 1982
- HCBS waivers are intended to give states flexibility to serve new populations and/or provide services in innovative ways
- Current Waiver Period: October 1, 2013 – September 30, 2018
- In the process of writing the waiver renewal
  - Providing the opportunity for changes and updates
  - Gather feed back from stakeholders and recipients
  - Potential updates to services and policies
