Revisions to MSM 2800 are being proposed to reflect the requirement in 34 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) under paragraph 300.154(d)(2)(iv) that parental consent be on file and to add a parental notification requirement as mandated by 34 CFR 300.154(d)(2)(v).

2. Discussion and Proposed changes to Medicaid Service Manual Chapter 100

Ms. Lynne Foster:

Revisions to MSM Chapter 100 are proposed to establish definitions, safeguards, and sanctions regarding confidential information as required by 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 431.301, the State Plan, Section 4.3, and Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 422.290. A new section defining confidential information, regulatory references, limitations on use and disclosure, authorized uses and disclosures, penalties, and data ownership is proposed.

The effective date is July 1, 2014.

<u>Ms. Stagliano</u> – Recommended the Deputy Administrator approved as amended; Section 100.1 under item D change the word "of" to "or" and in Section 100.2 third paragraph remove the extra word "in" and approve the rest of the chapter as submitted.

<u>Ms. Aiello</u> – Approved as submitted with the change of the word "of" to "or" and removing the word "in" within the phrase "in the statement regarding".

<u>Ms. Stagliano</u> – Closed the Public Hearing for the Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 100, Medicaid Program.

3. Discussion and Proposed changes to Medicaid Service Manual Chapter 600

Ms. Marti Cotè:

Revisions to MSM Chapter 600 are being proposed to clarify language pertaining to Rural Health Clinics/ Federally Qualified Health Centers (RHCs/FQHCs) and their encounter payment policy, as well as, an updated list of medical professionals who can provide services. Language was added regarding the coverage guidelines for our Teaching Physician policy.

Throughout the chapter, grammar, punctuation, and capitalization changes were made, duplications removed, acronyms used and standardized, and language reworded for clarity. Renumbering and Rearranging of sections was necessary.

The effective date is July 1, 2014.

At the conclusion of Ms. Cotè's presentation, Ms. Stagliano asked Ms. Aiello, Deputy Administrator, and Mr. Faircloth, DAG, if they had any questions or comments.

Ms. Aiello's Comments:

4. Discussion and Proposed changes to Medicaid Service Manual Chapter 1200

Ms. Mary Griffith:

Revisions to MSM Chapter 1200 were made to reflect approved actions by the Drug Use Review (DUR) Board at the July 25, 2013 meeting.

The DUR Board is a requirement of the Social Security Act to identify and reduce fraud, abuse, overuse, and medically unnecessary care. The DUR Board also works to minimize drug interactions, drug-induced illness, and undesirable drug reactions in recipients.

Prior authorization criteria was approved by the DUR Board on July 25, 2013 for the following drugs. Prior authorization criteria will be added or criteria will be revised to MSM Chapter 1200 for Eliquis® (apixaban); Pradaxa® (dabigatran etexilate); Xarelto® (rivaroxaban); Ampyra® (dalfampridine); Cymbalta® (duloxetine); Suboxone® (buprenorphine/naloxone); Subutex® (buprenorphine); Genotropin® (somatropin); Humatrope® (somatropin); Norditropin® (somatropin) Nutropin® (somatropin); Omnitrope® (somatropin); Saizen® (somatropin); Tev-Tropin® (somatropin); Serostim® (somatropin); Zorbtive® (somatropin); Cinryze® (C1 esterase inhibitor); Berinert® (C1 esterase inhibitor); Kalbitor® (ecallantide); Firazyr® (icatibant); Leukine® (sargramostim); Neulasta® (pegfilgrastim); Neupogen® (filgrastim); Subsys® (fentanyl sublingual spray); Onsolis® (fentanyl citrate buccal film); Fentora® (fentanyl citrate buccal tablet); Lazanda® (fentanyl citrate nasal spray); Abstral® (fentanyl citrate sublingual tablet); Cesamet® (nabilone); Marinol® (dronabinol); and Actiq® (fentanyl citrate transmucosal lozenge).

The length of prioritization approval for Omontys® (peginesatide) will be changed from one year to one month.

Clarifying language was added under Injectable Immunomodulators, Crohn's Disease.

Bone pain was removed under Cox-2 Inhibitors.

The effective date is July 1, 2014.
