Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) developed a new waiver called Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waiver for Structured Family Caregiving (SFCG), which must be submitted to Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for approval with an effective date of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2025. As part of the process, DHCFP is requesting public comment regarding this new waiver.

During the Nevada 82<sup>nd</sup> Legislative session, Assembly Bill 208 was passed to develop a new 1915(c) Waiver specifically for Structured Family Caregiving (SFCG). The new waiver is targeted to Medicaid recipients diagnosed with Dementia or a related condition. The following services are included in this waiver: Case management, Respite care, SFCG service including, without limitation, Home Health Aid Services. Services will be provided in accordance with this waiver and by qualified Medicaid providers who have enrolled through DHCFP's fiscal agent.
