#### **New Medicaid income limits**

If you are pregnant and work, you can still qualify for Medicaid, making up to \$2,300 a month and maybe more depending on how many people are in your household and your tax status. Your medical bills might even be covered for previous months if you qualify. To find out if you qualify go to: AccessNevada.dwss.nv.gov.

#### Kids qualify even if parents don't

Kids will not automatically Medicaid if lose parents don't qualify. Now, kids up to age 19 will get 12 months of continuous coverage if they qualify. complete your Always renewal packet because your kids might qualify, even if you don't.



### Don't pass diseases to your baby

See a doctor in the first three months of your pregnancy to prevent your baby from getting certain diseases. If you don't have a primary care physician, find a Federally Qualified Health Center.
