



# Medicaid Members: Your Health Plan May Change

Nevada Medicaid October, 2021

Nevada Medicaid is now offering more choices that require changes for some members and the health plans. Dental benefits are not changing. We appreciate your patience. For more information go to: <https://dhcfp.nv.gov/Members/BLU/MCOMain/>

## Why is the change happening?

- **630,000 Nevadans** are currently enrolled in three health plans.



- **More choices** are now available for Nevadans with a 4th health plan.



- **Nevada Medicaid requires** equal household distribution to each health plan.

## When is the change happening?

10/27/21

**You will receive a letter in the mail notifying you of this change**

12/15/21

**Check your mailbox for notification of your newly-assigned health plan**

1/1/22

**Members assigned a new health plan have 90 days to switch**

3/31/22

**Last day for members who are assigned a new health plan to switch**

4/1/22

**Open Enrollment for members who weren't assigned a new health plan**

10/1/22

**Open Enrollment: all members can choose a new health plan**

## What can I do?

1. **Update** your mailing address through the portal at [AccessNevada.DWSS.NV.GOV](https://AccessNevada.DWSS.NV.GOV) or call the Division of Welfare & Supportive Services at 702-486-1646 or 1-800-992-0900.
2. **Wait** for correspondence from Nevada Medicaid regarding your health plan.
3. **Review** Frequently-Asked Questions, **compare** each plan using the comparison chart, and on January 1, 2022 **switch** your plan if you wish using the [change form](#) on the Nevada Medicaid website: [DHCFP.nv.gov/Members/BLU/MCOMain/](https://DHCFP.nv.gov/Members/BLU/MCOMain/).
