

END OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY (PHE) TENTATIVE RENEWAL TIMELINE

Assuming the end of PHE is April 11, 2023, Nevada will begin initiating unwinding-related renewals the month after the PHE ends. This means that renewals will be initiated May 1, 2023, for individuals with a June 30, 2023 renewal date for July (renewal month) eligibility. The following timeline and process will apply to each month within the unwinding period.

1 APRIL 15, 2023



Ex-parte is executed approximately 15 days before the renewal packets are sent by mail.

Successful (approved) ex-parte (for July eligibility) renewal notices and paper renewal packets are mailed May 1, 2023, including any unsuccessful ex-parte, with a submission due date of June 30, 2023.

MAY 1, 2023

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JUNE 15, 2023



If the paper renewal packet is not received by June 15, 2023, a Notice of Decision (NOD) is sent automatically advising that eligibility will end if no contact or renewal packet is received.

This is the final day of eligibility for unresponsiveness. Renewal packets received by June 30, 2023, are processed and evaluated for eligibility. A notice of decision is sent advising of the eligibility upon determination.

If the beneficiary failed to return the renewal packet and is determined ineligible for Medicaid, starting July 1, 2023 they will have 90 days after July 1st to submit the completed renewal packet to be re-evaluated.

Use resources available to continue outreach for 14 months to keep Nevadans insured.
