Nevada Final Public Health Emergency Unwinding Report

The Nevada Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is releasing its final Public Health Emergency (PHE) Unwinding report reflecting collective data on Medicaid and Children Health Insurance Program (CHIP) enrollment, renewals and disenrollment during the Unwinding period. Nevada's Unwinding Period ended August 31, 2024, and throughout this critical period, Neveda monitored Medicaid Enrollment, Disenrollments and Renewals among other demographic data points using the Unwinding Data Dashboard. The final update to the dashboard was released on October 30, 2024, and can be accessed for archival purposes only (here). This report will also disclose current enrollment data as of December 2024.

Current enrollment for both Medicaid and CHIP exhibits a growth of 148,912 (~20% increase) since Pre-PHE.
