Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

The Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers for the Frail Elderly (FE) and Persons with Physical Disabilities (PD) are being amended to reflect the change in the minimum requirements for Case Management (CM) provider qualifications due to a shortage of qualified licensed case managers. The minimum requirements include the addition of non-licensed professionals but must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in social work, gerontology, counseling, nursing, psychology, human growth and development, special education, sociology, criminal justice or a closely related social science or human services field. This amendment will take effect November 18, 2024, or upon receipt of approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), whichever comes later.

The fiscal impact to Tribal Governments is unknown at this time.
