Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in State Plan:

Section VIII, Hospitals Serving Low-Income Patients Disproportionate Share Hospitals (DSH) of the Medicaid State Plan will need specific language to be updated for state fiscal year (SFY) 2025.

In Section VIII, subsection B (2), the DSH state plan rate year will be updated from "July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024" to the upcoming state fiscal year "July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025."

In Section VIII, subsection B (2), the total DSH to be paid out during the time period of July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025 will be updated from the previous fiscal year 2024 projection amount of "\$22,432,159.05" to the recently updated fiscal year 2025 projection amount of "\$25,138,225.17."

There is no fiscal impact to Tribal Governments.
