Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed changes to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan:

DHCFP is proposing updates to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan Attachment 2.6-A, Page 4a. In follow up to Senate Bill 45 (2023 Legislative Session), the proposed changes increase the amount of the Personal Needs Allowance (PNA) provided to eligible Medicaid recipients in Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID) from \$35 to \$154 beginning in 2024. This figure will be adjusted annually by the cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) as determined by the Social Security Administration (SSA).

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to tribal governments at this time.
