Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in the Medicaid Services Manual (MSM):

Revisions to the MSM Chapter 603.4E - Doula Services are being proposed to remove the need for a medical professional service and/or a dental service to grant additional Doula services. In addition, language will be added to specify that any services requiring medical or clinical licensure are not covered.

There is no anticipated financial impact to Tribal Governments.
