Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA):

The Division of Healthcare Financing and Policy is proposing an Amendment to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan, Attachment 4.19-A, Page 14 to amend the reimbursement rates for Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTF). Under the proposed change, the existing reimbursement methodology would be amended to change the reimbursement methodology to a \$800 flat rate and two add-on payment options. The add-on options are: \$100 for intensive treatment services for children under age nine and \$100 for intensive treatment services for serving children with specialized needs in a PRTF setting.
