**Dear Tribal Members:** 

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed new waiver:

During the 82<sup>nd</sup> Nevada Legislative session, Assembly Bill 208 was passed to develop a new 1915(c) Waiver called Structured Family Caregiving. The targeted population is individuals who have a diagnosis of Dementia or related conditions. The criteria for this waiver are: must meet a Nursing Facility (NF) Level of Care (LOC) and income eligibility, and must have a need for at least one (1) waiver service. Services in this waiver include Case Management, Personal Care Services, Respite, Homemaker, Health Related Services, including, without limitation, Home Health Aid Services. Services will be provided in accordance with this waiver and by qualified Medicaid providers. In order for recipients to receive these services, a caregiver must be residing full-time with the recipient or vice versa.

The fiscal impact to Tribal Governments is unknown at this time.
