Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed updates to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan Attachment 3.1-A Page 2a:

The State Plan Amendment (SPA) to Attachment 3.1-A Page 2a will allow school-based providers, including school counselors, school social workers, and school psychologists, with a Department of Education endorsement and current licensure to bill for covered services provided to school age Medicaid recipients in a school setting.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact on the tribal governments.
