Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Nevada Health Authority (NVHA) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed policy:

The NVHA is proposing revisions to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan, Attachment 4.19-A, Page 31e. The Amendment will add a new program of managed care inpatient indirect graduate medical education (IME) for qualifying public teaching hospitals with approved Graduate Medical Education Programs.

This State Plan Amendment (SPA) is anticipated to impact certain hospitals that are Medicaid enrolled providers delivering inpatient services in managed care.

Estimated change in aggregate inpatient expenditures: An estimated increase in annual aggregate expenditure for state fiscal year (SFY):

FY 2026:	\$9,812,913
FY 2027:	\$10,009,171

The effective date of the proposed change is July 1, 2025.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to Tribal Governments.
