Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Nevada Health Authority (NVHA) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed changes to policy:

The Division of Nevada Medicaid is proposing changes to the Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 200, Attachment A, Policy 02-02 – Federal Emergency Services (FES) Program. Policy is being revised to clarify the limited scope of reimbursable services available to Emergency Medicaid only (EMO) recipients. Services under this eligibility group are limited to the stabilizing treatment of an emergency medical condition, labor and delivery, and ESRD services. These proposed changes will be presented at public hearing on October 28th, 2025.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to tribal governments.
