**Dear Tribal Members:** 

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed changes to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan:

The DHCFP is proposing a State Plan Amendment (SPA) to update the methodology used to determine the payments to private free-standing nursing facilities through an existing supplemental payment. This update will change the cadence used to calculate the payments. Additionally, the SPA will clarify the total value of the payments. The changes being proposed are being made to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan Attachment 4.19-D Pages 10a through 10f with an effective date of July 1, 2025.

Specifically:

The current component elements and weighting used to determine the supplemental fee-for-service payment amounts for each facility will remain the same. Rather than computing the payment amounts on a quarterly basis, the State will perform these calculations on an annual basis. The total value of the payments is not expected to be impacted by this methodological change.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to tribal governments.
