Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed changes to the State Plan:

The Division is proposing an amendment to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan Attachment 4.19-B, Page 1a to increase the reimbursement rates for Anesthesia Conversion factor from \$23.70 to \$26.07 and a pediatric enhanced conversion factor of \$29.98 for recipients under the age of six (6). This change was made in response to concerns about anesthesia care access.

The estimated change in annual aggregate expenditures is an estimated increase in annual aggregate expenditures for

SFY 2026:	\$861,179
SFY 2027:	\$898,506

There is no fiscal impact to tribal governments.
