Filling gaps in care

Whole-person care is more than what a member receives at a doctor's appointment. With Anthem's member programs and value-added benefits, we help members work toward whole-person wellness. Here is a list of what we offer:

- **Eyeglass frames or hardware** One pair per year up to \$100 for our members
- **WW**® (formerly Weight Watchers) voucher With provider permission, we pay for the sign up fee and a member's choice of 13 weeks of in-person classes or 14 weeks of online classes. This is a one-time benefit for members 17+.
- **Disease Management** We offer a support and education program to help members control ongoing health conditions like asthma, diabetes, and COPD.
- **Free <FitnessCoach> app** With this app, services include online exercise classes and online information on fitness and exercise topics.



- Free GED testing Prep materials and testing are covered for members.
- Free dental hygiene kits Members can request them through customer service.
- Free Costco gold membership Costco provides discounted items that will benefit financially vulnerable individuals and families. One membership is allowed per household a year, without an age restriction.
- Free cell phone Through Safe Link, members have up to 350 minutes of service each month for qualified members, plus 200 extra one-time bonus minutes when they choose to get free health text messages. Members enrolled with case management can receive a 4G monthly plan.
- Anthem Medicaid Mobile Our app for smartphones allows members to safely access their ID card, find a doctor, and explore health and wellness information on the go.
