SUPPORT Act Post Planning Demonstration



September 17, 2021, Nevada was among five states awarded the CMS SUPPORT Act Post-Planning Demonstration Grant Award

Nevada will continue work identified through the Strategic Plan; some major strategies include but are not limited to:

- Development of a new Provider Type and individual specialties for Substance Use Treatment Providers
- Nevada's Section 1115 Demonstration Waiver application entitled "Nevada's Treatment of Opioid Use Disorders (OUDs) and Substance Use Disorders (SUDs) Transformation Project"



New Provider Type (PT) and Specialties

- New PT will replace current PT 17 specialty 215
- Will allow Alcohol and Drug Counselors, Interns, and Peer Supporters to enroll as individuals and link to the group
- Working with Gainwell on a Roll Out Plan and Provider Training
- Creating new Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) for Substance Use Disorder Treatment to be separate from MSM 400







1115 SUD Waiver Demonstration Progress

CMS provided 1115 application approval on December 29, 2022



ASAM Level 3.1 -Clinically Managed Low-intensity Residential Services ASAM Level 3.2 -Clinically Managed Residential Withdrawal Management

ASAM Level 3.5 -Clinically Managed High-Intensity Residential Services

ASAM Level 3.7 -Medically Monitored Inpatient Withdrawal Management ASAM Level 4.0 – Medically Managed Intensive Inpatient Services





SUD Implementation Plan approved by CMS on May 24th

With Plan approval, Medicaid is working with the Division of Public and Behavioral Health and Gainwell to activate reimbursement for services under Medicaid





Mobile Crisis Planning Grant



Planning Grant ending September 29, 2023



As part of NV SPA 22-0005, coverage language for Mobile Crisis response delivered by a Designated Mobile Crisis Team (DMCT) remains under review with CMS



New Provider Type 87 – Crisis Services ready to implement upon CMS approval



Mobile Crisis Planning Grant Cont.

Provider Type 87 Specialty 031

Designated Mobile Crisis
Teams

- Minimum of at least 2-person team responding
- At least 1 team member to respond in person
- Available 24/7/365
- Enhanced rate
- No prior authorization

Provider Type 87 Specialty 032

Designated Mobile Crisis
Teams attached to a CCBHC

- Minimum of at least 2-person team responding
- At least 1 team member to respond in person
- Available 24/7/365
- Able to be reimbursed on the same day as another service delivered by the CCBHC separate from the Prospective Payment System (PPS) rate
- No prior authorization
