SAMHSA'S SPF



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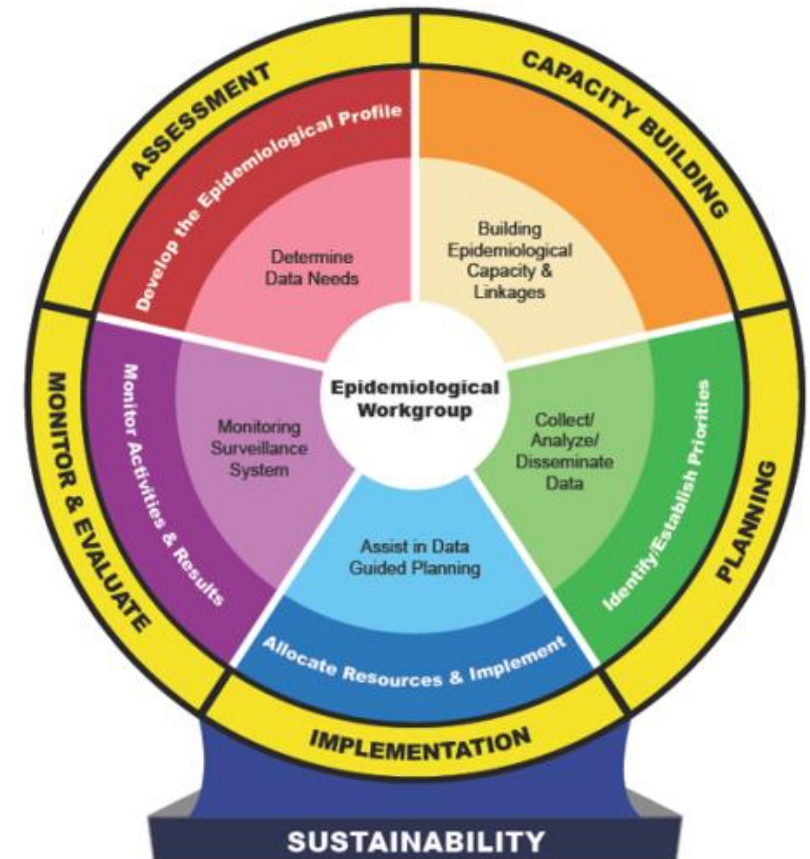


EPIDEMIOLOGICAL OUTCOMES WORKGROUPS

PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICES

- Establish and maintain regular contacts with advisory group and/or key decision makers
- Ensure ongoing and meaningful exchange of data and information between SEOW and state leaders/staff
