- ❖ From *October 1, 2024*, through *September 30, 2025* (Finalized)
- ❖ Focuses on providing eligible individuals with practical nutrition education and resources to promote active lifestyles and reduce the risk of obesity at no financial burden to them.
- ❖ Offers customizable resources tailored to the specific needs and cultural preferences of diverse communities.



Goals

- ❖ Increase fruits and vegetables consumption.
- ❖ Reduce consumption of sugary-sweetened beverages.
- ❖ Increase food resources management skills.
- ❖ Increase physical activity participation.
