### **Important Considerations**

- New framework designed to ensure the proper and efficient administration of the Medicaid program to better ensure that services are provided in a manner consistent with the best interest of the beneficiaries.
- **Primary role** of both the MAC and BAC, is to advise the State Medicaid agency on policy development and on matters related to the *effective* administration of the Medicaid program.
- BAC will be comprised of current or former Medicaid beneficiaries and individuals with direct experience supporting Medicaid beneficiaries.



# Final Rule: CMS 2442-F Ensuring Access to Medicaid Services

- Also called "The Access Rule"
- Renames the Medical Care Advisory Committee to the Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC)
- Creates a Beneficiary Advisory Committee (BAC)
- 25% of the membership of the MAC will be comprised of members from the BAC
- Annual report must be posted for both the MAC and BAC activities



# MAC Membership

- State or local consumer advocacy groups or other community-based organizations that represent the interests of, or provide direct service, to Medicaid beneficiaries
- Clinical providers or administrators who are familiar with the health and social needs of Medicaid beneficiaries with the resources available and required for their care
- Participating Managed Care Organizations
- Other State agencies serving Medicaid beneficiaries as ex-officio members



#### Other Potential MAC Members

#### Demographic representation could include:

- Pediatric health care
- Behavioral health services
- 3. Preventive care and reproductive health services
- 4. Health or services issues pertaining specifically to people over age 65
- 5. Health or service issues pertaining specifically to people with disabilities
