

Supporting Healthcare Infrastructure

SilverSummit is committed to strengthening Nevada's healthcare infrastructure. We've already invested \$650,000 into rural provider capacity—including critical access hospitals and housing support organizations—to ensure communities are ready for the transition to managed care.

Over the next five years, \$650,000 committed

Over the next **five years**, SilverSummit intends to invest a **larger**, **unspecified amount** into statewide initiatives focused on:

- Workforce Development
 - Provider workforce The goal is to build capacity within providers to help them absorb the operational changes that come with transitioning to managed care
 - Member skills or learning development
- Housing Supports Programs
- Food Security Programs

Applying for Community Investment Program

Commitment to 13 CAHS/RHCS

With a strategic focus on rural Critical Access Hospitals and Rural Health Centers, SilverSummit is committed to providing financial investments in 2025 and 2026. This investment supports our commitment to empowering Nevada Providers to increase access to care.

To be eligible, each hospital or health center must meet the following:

- Must have an active SilverSummit contract
- Legally operate as a critical access hospital or rural health center in Nevada
- Must be a Nevada Medicaid Provider in good standing

Investments can be used to support:

- Recruitment of new Providers
- Graduate Medical Education programs
- Programs to advance existing staff capabilities
- Technology enhancements
