


NV Medicaid sPDL

- **What's Changing?**
 - Effective January 1, 2026, Nevada Medicaid will follow one unified PDL.
 - Includes:
 - ✓ Drugs on the Nevada Medicaid PDL
 - ✓ Utilization Management (Prior Authorization, Quantity Limits)
 - ✓ Certain Physician Administered-Drugs
 - ✓ Diabetic Supplies
- **Who is impacted?**
 - All Nevada Medicaid recipients in Fee-for-Service or Managed Care Organization.
- **What is the objective?**
 - Reduce the administrative burden for providers and recipients, simplify the prior authorization process, enhance continuity of care, and support improved health outcomes for all Nevada Medicaid recipients.



NV Medicaid sPDL Timeline



- ✓ SPDL Implemented as of January 1, 2026
- ✓ Commence Legacy Coverage Phase
- **Monitoring to maintain continuity of care.**



Legacy Coverage Phase

- **Period:**

- January 1, 2026, through June 30, 2026

- **Purpose:**

- To support transition to SPDL and maintain continuity of care.
- Allow time for providers and members to adjust and, when appropriate, switch to a preferred medication.
