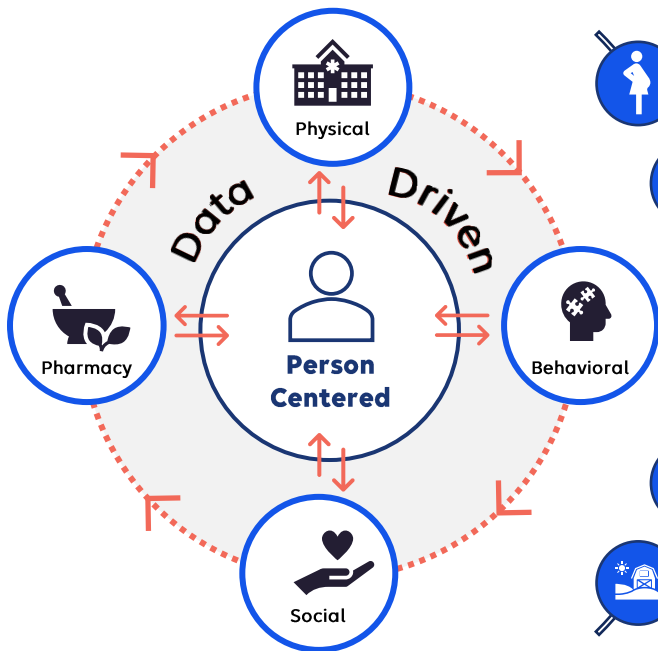

Maternal and Child Health. Eliminating health disparities, improving birth outcomes, and improving the health of women and children across Nevada.
- 
Chronic Disease Management. Helping Members reduce the risk of and manage chronic conditions.
- 
Access to Behavioral Health. Improving Member access to mental health and substance use disorder (SUD) services.
- 
Social Drivers of Health. Addressing SDOH needs in five key areas: healthcare, education, social, economic stability, and neighborhood.
- 
Prevention and Vaccination. Promoting healthy habits, preventative screenings/visits, and increasing vaccination rates across all communities
- 
Rural Health and Network. Increasing access to care and addressing disparities in rural populations.

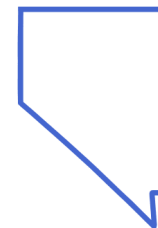

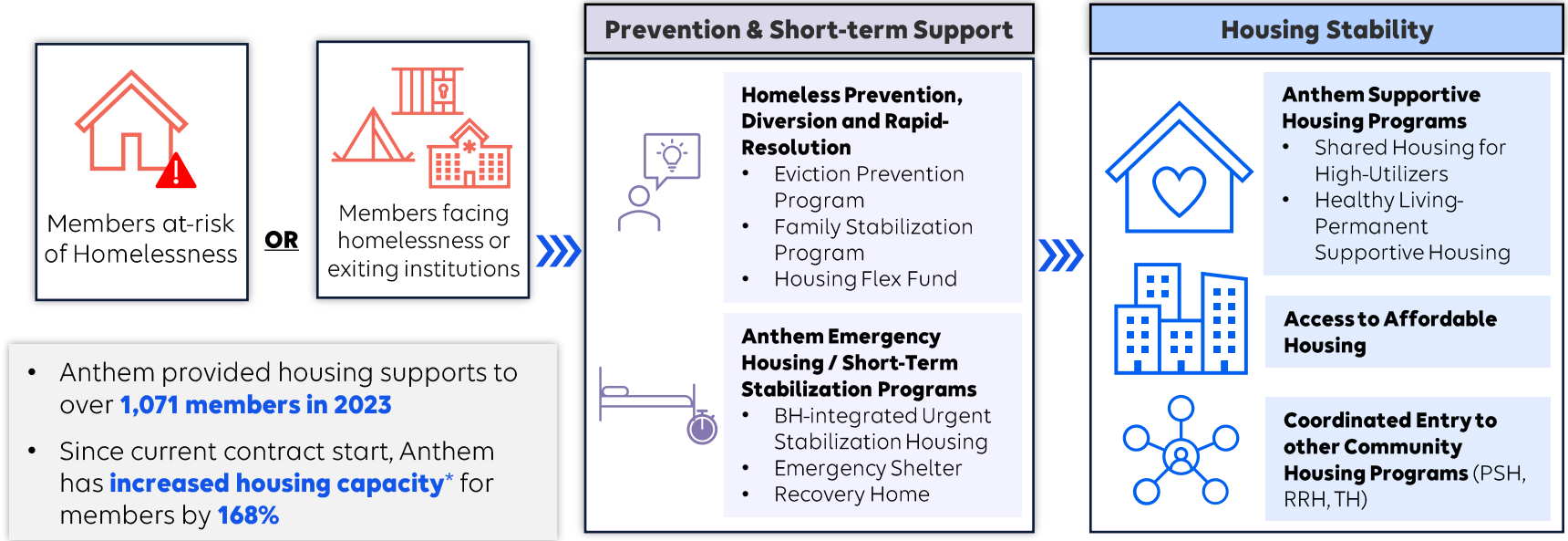

Anthem addresses housing instability to improve health outcomes



*Capacity defined as # of shelter and supportive housing beds and # of households served annually by other housing supports such as homeless prevention/deposit assistance.



2023 Housing Support Outcomes



85 Households **prevented from homelessness**



33 Families w/children provided **emergency shelter**



645 total number of members assisted with **Crisis Stabilization Housing**



621 total number of **permanent housing placements**



1,071 total number of **households served** across all housing programs

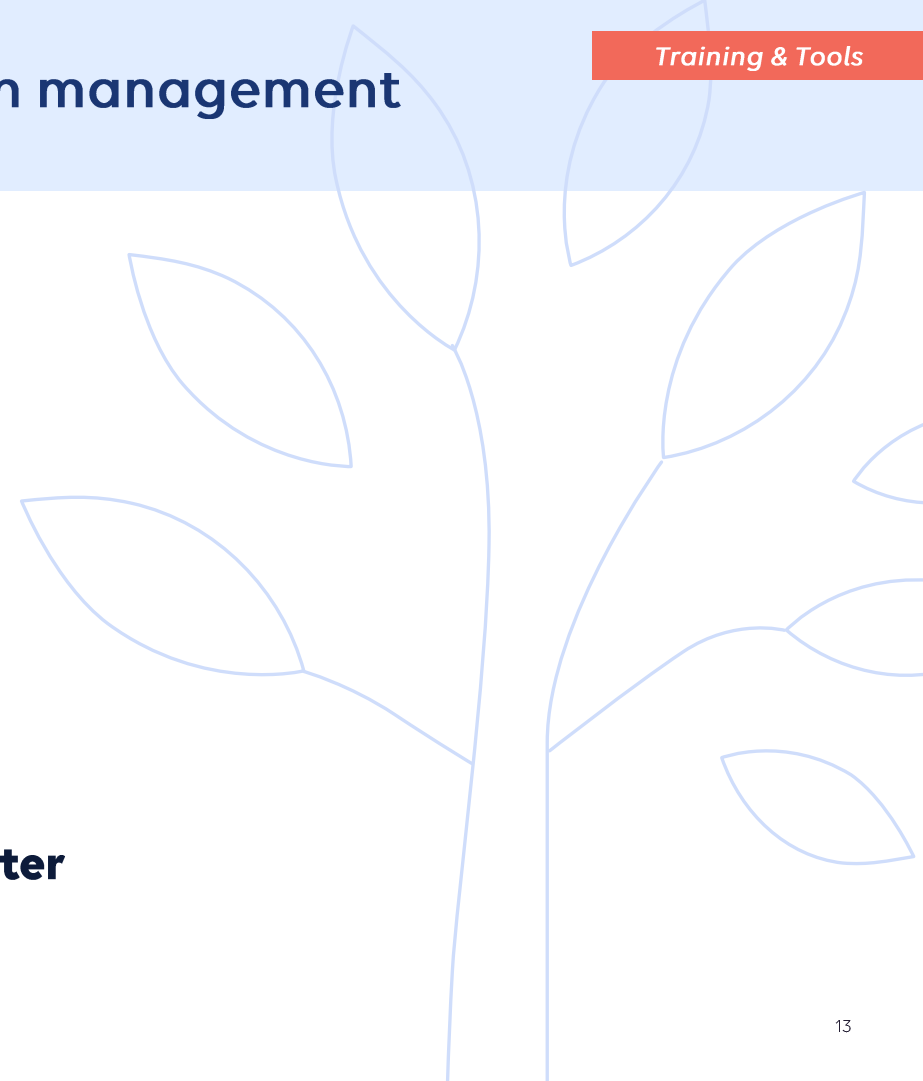
