Revisions to the Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 1200 – Prescribed Drugs are being proposed to clarify coverage limitations of drugs without a Food and Drug Administration (FDA)-approved indication. The proposed changes also identify drug classes that are exempt from Nevada Medicaid Preferred Drug List (PDL) restrictions under Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 422.4025. In addition, the proposed revisions update the current prior authorization criteria for Ponvory[®] (ponesimod) to reflect trial and failure requirements of one Multiple sclerosis (MS) disease-modifying therapy as recommended and approved by the Drug Utilization Review Board (DUR).

Revisions to MSM Chapter 1200 Prescribed Drugs are being proposed to reflect recommendations approved on the April 20, 2023, by the Drug Utilization Review (DUR) Board. The proposed changes include the addition of new clinical and PA criteria for Leqembi (lecanemab-irmb) within the Alzheimer's Disease Agents Section; updated existing clinical criteria for Epidiolex (cannabidiol) and added new prior authorization criteria for Ztalmy (ganaxolone) within the Anticonvulsants Section; addition of new prior authorization criteria for Verkazia[®] (cyclosporine) within the newly created Ophthalmic Anti-Inflammatory Agents Section.

Revisions to MSM Chapter 2300 – Waiver for Persons with Physical Disabilities (PD Waiver) are being proposed to align with the PD Waiver renewal approved January 1, 2023, and the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Final Regulation. Some of the proposed major changes are: The addition of a Private Case Management (PCM) provider as another choice for case management services provided to waiver recipients. The addition of Legally Responsible Individuals (LRI) to the pool of paid caregivers for personal care-like services such as attendant care, homemaker, respite, chores and its coverages and limitations. Addition of the HCBS Final Regulation requirements (i.e., modification of plan of care, residential settings requirements, and the person-centered planning process). Modifications to the waiver slot wait list. Transferring appropriate Sections of the disability determination process to MSM Chapter 2300 from the MOM Chapter 1000 that will be obsolete.

Revisions to MSM Chapter 2200 – Home and Community Based Waiver for the Frail Elderly (FE Waiver) are being proposed to align with the FE Waiver Amendment approved April 1, 2023, and the HCBS Final Regulation. Some of the proposed major changes are: The addition of a PCM provider as another choice for case management services provided to waiver recipients. The addition of LRI to the pool of paid caregivers for personal care-like services such as adult companion, homemaker, respite, chores, and its coverages and limitations. Addition of the HCBS Final Regulation requirements (i.e., modification of plan of care, residential settings requirements, and the person-centered planning process). Modifications to the waiver slot wait list.
