Introduction:

Casey Angres, Chief of Division Compliance, DHCFP, opened the Public Hearing introducing herself, Malinda Southard, Deputy Administrator, DHCFP, and Gabriel Lither, Senior Deputy Attorney General.

Casey Angres – The notice for this public hearing was published on September 28, 2023, and revised on October 16, 2023, in accordance with Nevada Statute 422.2369.

- 2. Discussion and Proposed Adoption and Changes to MSM 600

Subject: MSM Chapter 600, Section 603.14C – Physician Services

Stephanie Sadabseng, Social Services Program Specialist in the Medical Benefits Coverage Unit, DHCFP, presented a Nevada Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) update is being proposed to add language to MSM 600 — Physician Services, Section 603.14C, Provider's Services in Other Medical Facilities, indicating pediatric cancer and pediatric rare disease providers are allowed to provide services in a clinic setting to treat children for cancer and rare disease types as medically necessary.

The effective date of this new policy is November 1, 2023.

At the conclusion of Stephanie Sadabseng's presentation, Casey Angres asked Malinda Southard and Gabriel Lither if they had any questions or comments, they had none.

Public Comments: There were none.

Malinda Southard approved the changes, pending spelling and grammar checks.

Casey Angres – Closed the Public Hearing for proposed adoption and changes to MSM Chapter 600, Section 603.14C –Physician Services.

3. Discussion and Proposed Adoption and Changes to MSM 600

Subject: MSM Chapter 600, Section 603.3 – Physician Services

Evette Cullen, Chief of the Medical Benefits Coverage Unit, DHCFP, advised pursuant to the passing of Senate Bill (SB) 280 during the 82nd 2023 Legislative Session, Nevada MSM Chapter 600 - Physician Services, Section 603 updates will allow injectable contraception or insertion of certain long-acting reversible contraception (LARCs) to be administered immediately after giving birth if requested by a patient.

This proposed policy update may affect the following Provider Types (PT), including but not limited to: Physicians (PT 20).

The effective date of this new policy is November 1, 2023.

At the conclusion of Evette Cullen's presentation, Casey Angres asked Malinda Southard and Gabriel Lither if they had any questions or comments, they had none.

Public Comments: There were none.

Malinda Southard approved the changes, pending spelling and grammar checks.

Casey Angres – Closed the Public Hearing for proposed adoption and changes to MSM Chapter 600, Section 603.3 –Physician Services.

4. Discussion and Proposed Adoption and Changes to MSM 600

Subject: MSM Chapter 600, Section 605 – Physician Services

Evette Cullen, Chief of the Medical Benefits Coverage Unit, DHCFP, presented pursuant to the passing of SB 117 during the 82nd 2023 Legislative Session, Nevada MSM Chapter 600 - Physician Services, Section 605 is being revised to update the allowable providers who may supervise Community Health Workers (CHW). Additional providers to include Dentists, Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSW), Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (LMFT), Clinical Professional Counselors, Nurse Anesthetists, and Nurse Midwives are being proposed to be allowed to supervise CHWs.

This proposed policy update may affect the following PTs, including but not limited to: Dentist (PT 22), Licensed Clinical Social Worker (PT 14, Specialty 302), Licensed Marriage Family Therapist (PT 14, Specialty 306), Clinical Professional Counselor (PT 14, Specialty 307), Nurse Midwife (PT 74), and Nurse Anesthetist (PT 72).

The effective date of this new policy is November 1, 2023, pending CMS approval of the State Plan Amendment (SPA) made in relation to this policy update.

At the conclusion of Evette Cullen's presentation, Casey Angres asked Malinda Southard and Gabriel Lither if they had any questions or comments, they had none.

Public Comments: There were none.

Malinda Southard approved the changes, pending spelling and grammar checks.

Casey Angres – Closed the Public Hearing for proposed adoption and changes to MSM Chapter 600, Section 605 –Physician Services.

5. Discussion and Proposed Adoption and Changes to MSM 600

Subject: MSM Chapter 600, Section 608 – Physician Services

Stephanie Sadabseng, Social Services Program Specialist in the Medical Benefits Coverage Unit, DHCFP, advised as a result of the passage of SB 163 during the 82nd Legislative Session, a Nevada MSM update is being proposed to MSM Section 600 – Physician Services, Section 608, Gender Reassignment Services.

Gender incongruence has been added as a covered condition for treatment services along with a definition as defined by the World Professional Association for Transgender Health (WPATH). Gender incongruence describes a marked and persistent experience of an incompatibility of gender identity and the gender expected based on birth assigned sex.

Non covered services under Section D have been updated, removing itemized list of cosmetic procedures not covered, and inputting language that cosmetic surgery not deemed medically necessary will not be a covered benefit.

The effective date of this new policy is November 1, 2023.

At the conclusion of Stephanie Sadabseng's presentation, Casey Angres asked Malinda Southard and Gabriel Lither if they had any questions or comments, they had none.

Public Comments: There were none.

Malinda Southard approved the changes, pending spelling and grammar checks.
