3. To remove Medication Assisted Treatment from PHP and IOP bundled services.





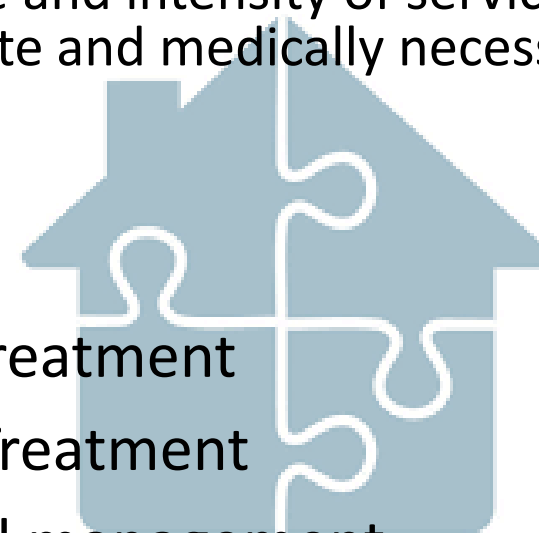
Residential Substance Use Treatment

Definition of Residential Services:

Residential substance use treatment programs that provide individuals in recovery from substance use and co-occurring disorders a safe and stable 24-hour setting that is staffed by designated addiction treatment personnel. Within a regimen of care that is planned and structured, skill restoration and counseling services are provided on-site. The type and intensity of service is determined by the patient's need and must be clinically appropriate and medically necessary through prior authorization.

Covered ASAM residential levels of care:

- 3.1: Clinically Managed Low-Intensity Residential Treatment
- 3.5: Clinically Managed High-Intensity Residential Treatment
- 3.7WM: Medically monitored inpatient withdrawal management

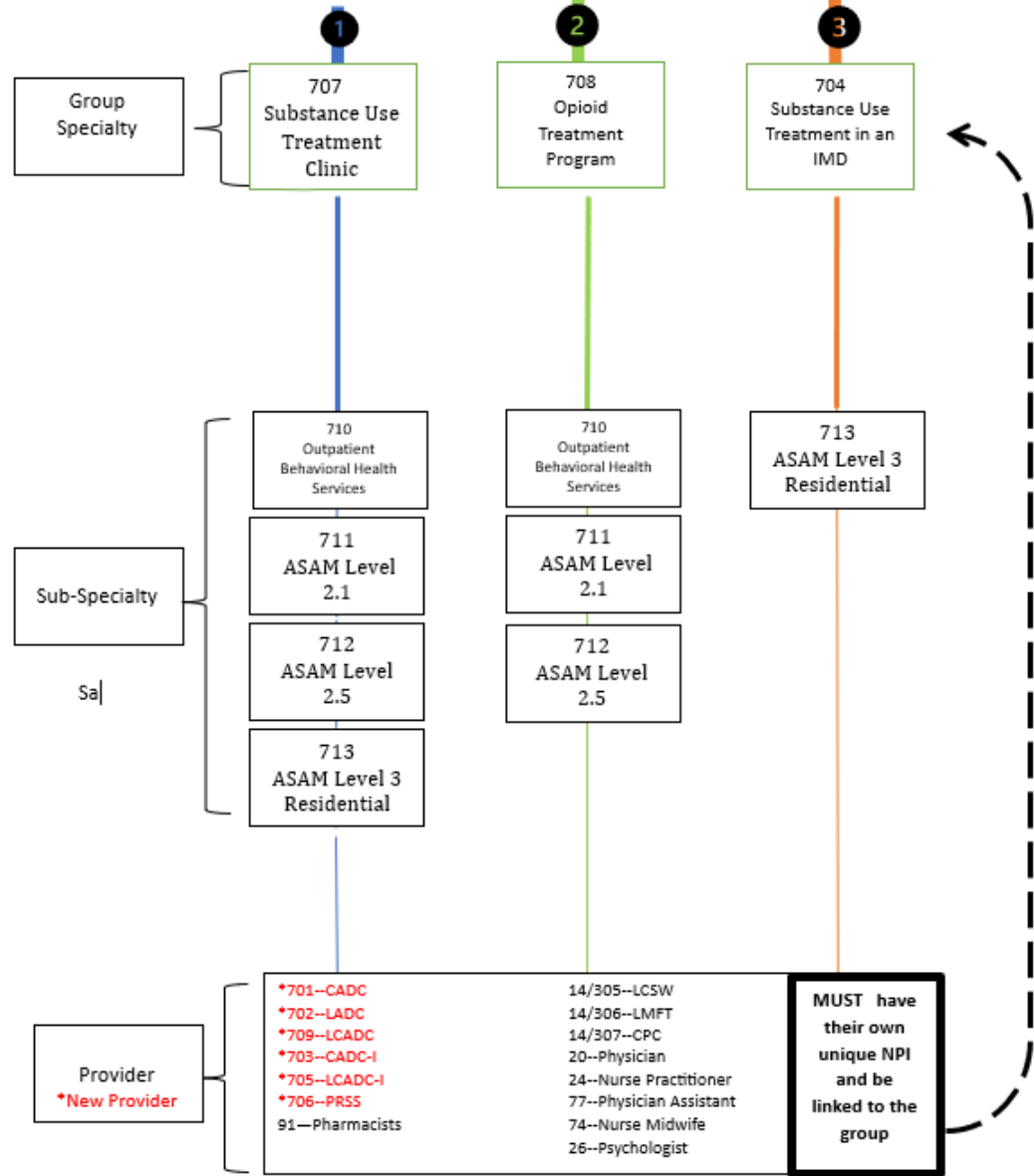
