In 2021, the Nevada Legislature authorized Doulas as Nevada Medicaid providers. In collaboration with practicing doulas throughout Nevada, Nevada Medicaid has implemented provider type (PT 90 - Doula) and policy approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid

Services (See Announcement 2853 at Medicaid.nv.gov)



Doulas may enroll as a PT 90 as an independent provider or group with Nevada Medicaid. Providers may request enrollment that is retroactive to their Doula Certification effective date as issued by the Nevada Certification Board See Web Announcement 2753 at Medicaid.nv.gov

How to enroll



- 1. Apply and obtain a Doula Certification from the Nevada Certification Board.
- 2. Visit PT 90 Doula Provider Enrollment Checklist to see a list of necessary documents.
- 3. Apply as a Nevada Medicaid PT 90 -Doula at Provider Enrollment.

Certification:

Doula Services per Nevada Medicaid policy are delivered by a non-medical trained professional who advocates, provides education and facilitates access to offers emotional resources. and and support during physical pregnancy, labor/delivery, and postpartum.
