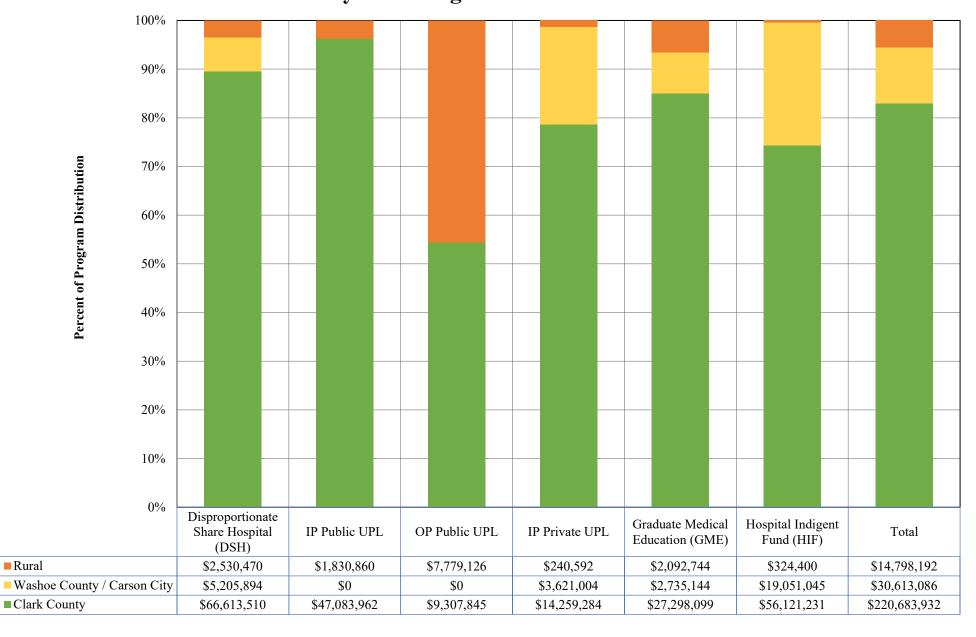
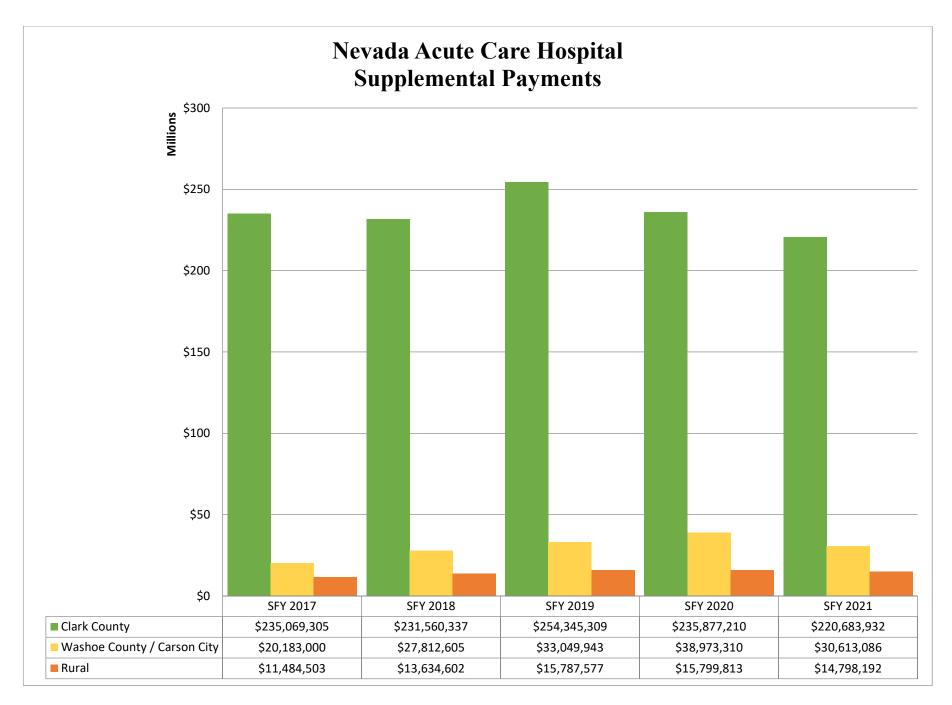
Nevada Acute Care Hospital SFY 2019 Supplemental Payment Program Distribution
