Overview

- The proposed change is to ensure State Plan covers Medicaid recipients for items and services furnished in connection with participation in a Qualifying Clinical Trials (QCT).
- As a result of an amendment to the 2021
 "Consolidated Appropriation Act" (CAA), section
 1905 (a) of the Social Security Act (SSA) (42 U.S.C.
 1396d) and 1902 (a)(10)(A) and 1937 (b)(5) of the
 Act to make this coverage mandatory.



Policy Changes

- State Plan Amendment
 - Templates provided by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS): 3.1-A and 3.1-B
 - Attachment 3.1-A: Amount, Duration and Scope of Services provided, Categorically Needy Group(s)
 - Attachment 3.1-B: Amount, Duration and Scope of Services provided, Medically Needy Group(s)
- Medicaid Services Manual updates:
 - Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) 1500, Attachment A Policy#15-1 Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) programs
 - MSM 600 Physician Services

Next steps

- Tribal Consultation: Present proposal of policy language and changes and seek feedback.
- Public Workshop:
 - Present policy proposal of removal of clinical trial limitations set in MSM 1500, Attachment A Policy#15-1;
 - Introduce new proposed language draft in MSM 600 – Physicians; and
 - State Plan amendment
- Public Hearing: SPA, MSM 1500 and MSM 600

 DHCFP is working with CMS and with our fiscal agent to understand implications this policy may or may not have to the Medicaid Management Information (MMIS) System and whether these clinical trial related services must be tracked.
