

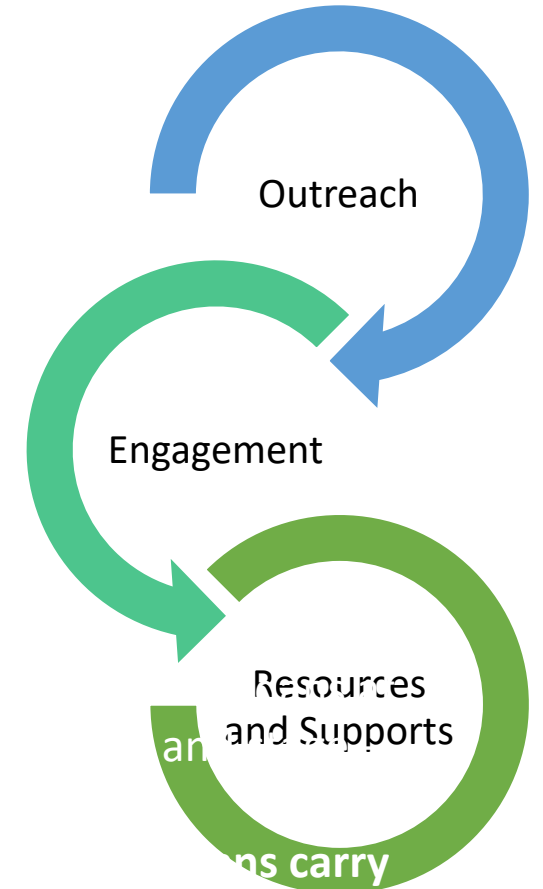
#### Monoclonal Antibodies Approved for Treatment of COVID-19 Infection (June 7, 2021)

#### New COVID-19 Vaccine Codes and Vaccine Administration Codes

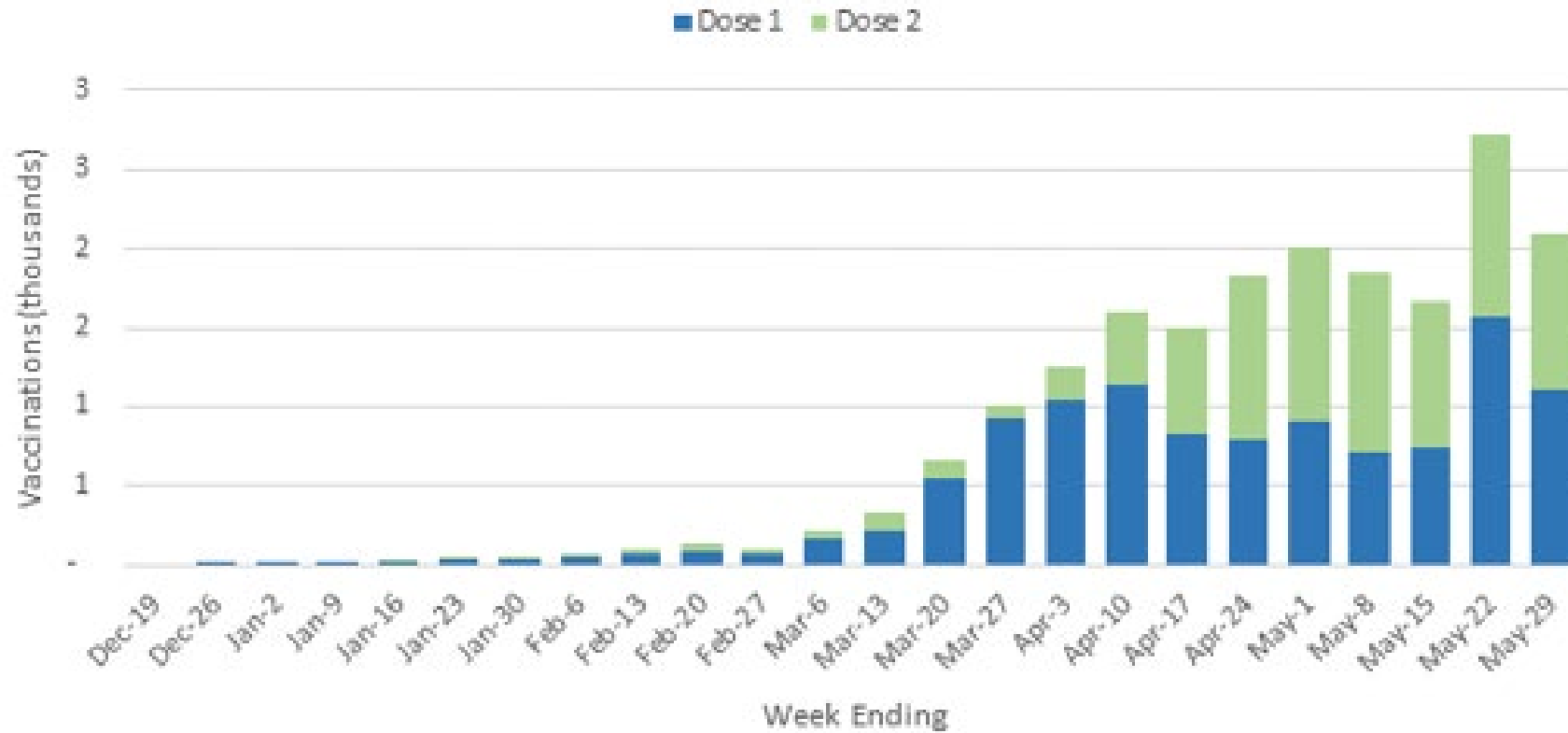
New COVID-19 vaccine codes and corresponding vaccine administration codes and the impacted provider types.



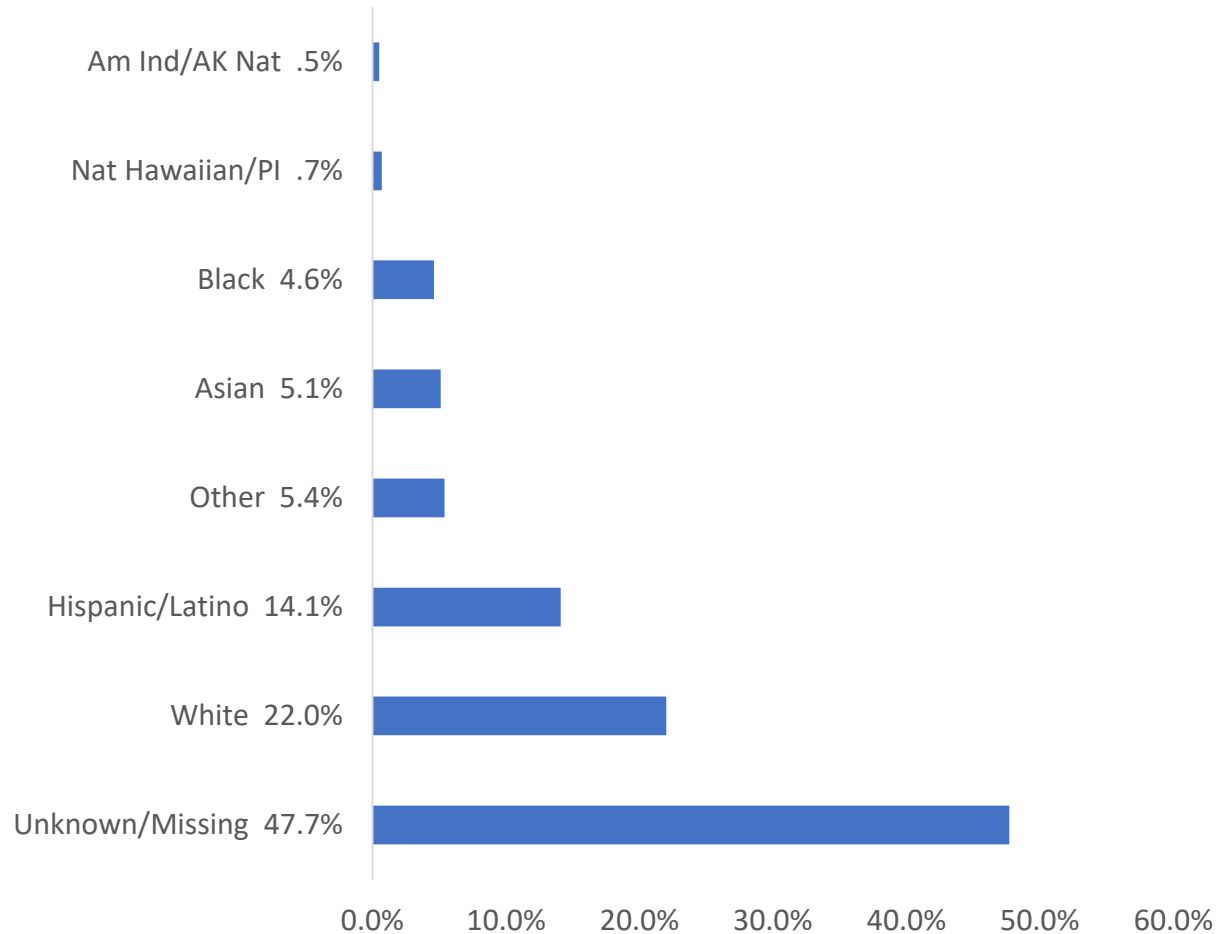
