Reinvesting in Nevada

Health Plan of Nevada (HPN) and UnitedHealthcare (UHC) have a long history of investing in large and small community partners in Nevada.

- Multi-million dollar investments in permanent supportive housing program with CPLC and VoA
- Financially supported Clark County's Hospital to Home and Healthy Living Programs
- Multi-million dollar grant to UNLV SOM and Touro University to improve access to care
- \$1M investment in Catholic Charities of Southern Nevada
- \$1M to six CBOs in 2021 to address BH, SDOH, and health literacy needs

Access to Care

- Mobile clinics - obstetrical care and primary care
- Behavioral health services in schools, communities and organizations
- Health literacy programs



Social Determinants of Health

- Long-term supportive housing
- Food security - large and small food banks and gardens, MOW
- Transportation - Uber Health
- Employment development programs



Women and Children

- Baby equipment (safe transport and sleep), supplies, formula, food, milk
- Multi-cultural prenatal, birthing, and postpartum services
- Child abuse prevention and parenting programs



Health Equity

- Project Echo (provider training health equity)
- Re-entry programs
- Minority women's preventive health services
- LGBTQ+ affirmation, counseling programs
